

Zimbabwe Update:

On Thursday 7 Friday of last week 25 churches participated in packing supplies to be sent to our Ukama partner churches in Zimbabwe (Brookside is partnered with Sakubva Church and sent 4 boxes of school/office and household supplies).

Hi Friends,

Well, it wasn't the smoothest of container situations, but it's off! And here are the stats compiled one of the many required commercial invoice and customs declarations forms! We sent:

- 20 boxes of athletic supplies
- 20 bicycles
- 112 boxes of books
- 193 boxes of clothing
- 153 boxes of household goods (some were labeled bedding or personal care or whatever, but for the invoice, it is now household goods....)

- 189 boxes/items of medical supplies (likely more than 189, this includes crutches and canes, some of which may not have been counted)
- 5 pieces of music equipment
- 17 boxes of office supplies
- 134 boxes or items labeled as school supplies (including desks, chairs --which counted as 1 item-- and other classroom items, etc.)
- 71 boxes of sewing/sewing machines (and boy, were some of those heavy!)
- 24 boxes of shoes
- 38 boxes/items labeled tools
- 21 boxes of toys
- 9 boxes of yarn

Woohoo! That's quite an accomplishment!

The cargo is expected to be loaded on the vessel CMA CGM Verdi out of New York by Friday, 8/22.

It is expected in Beira in early November. I generally track the ship and let you know when it hits Beira, Mozambique where it stays for a few days awaiting licenses and more documents and when it gets to Mutare Dry Port for inspection. The tricky part is that often they change cargo ships once or twice!


I will let you know when the Beira and Mutare milestones are reached. Enjoy the rest of your summer!
