Pentecost Sunday - Sunday, June 8



Campers will sketch ideas, create scale models, and help map out the final design through hands-on planning, learning how artists turn big ideas into finished work.

☐ Learn Professional Art Techniques

From using a projector for tracing to proper brush handling and color fill-ins, kids will build real mural-making skills and get messy in the best way.

☐ Take Responsibility for the Studio

Every camper helps prep, clean, and care for the space—learning that being part of a creative team means showing up for each other.

☐ Balance Creativity with Outdoor Play

Camp days include breaks for games, outdoor time, and solo creativity, making sure kids stay energized, focused, and inspired.


